4. Trust His care (10:24-42).

**MONDAY:**

Matthew 9:32-10:15

What strikes you about Jesus's actions and words in 9:32-38? What prevents you from having the compassion of Christ when you look at the people around you? What can you do to see the need more?

**TUESDAY:**

1 Timothy 2:1-7

How does God's attitude toward kings, authorities, and all people differ from yours? Why do you not have a desire for all men to come to the knowledge of the truth? How could your prayers change that?

**WEDNESDAY:**

Luke 24:44-49

Jesus preached the gospel or good news. What is good about the news we are commissioned to preach here? How have you seen God's power clothing your evangelism? How does that encourage your evangelism?

**THURSDAY:**

Exodus 3:1-4:13

If you had an experience like Moses's how would it impact you? How is your experience actually better than Moses's (cf. Heb 1:1-4)? How do you respond like Moses did? How should your experience change that response?

**FRIDAY:**

Matthew 9:32-10:15

What kind of confidence does it give you that Christ shares His authority with you? How about that He takes care of His disciples' needs? What evidence is in your life that you take His delegation and provision seriously?

Isaiah 7:1-16
